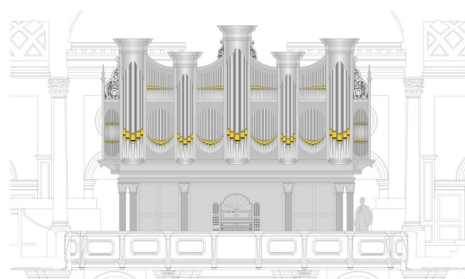


Pipe Sponsorships for Opus XVIII

OPUS XVIII—A modern classic

For a church with as rich a musical heritage as St George's Hanover Square, the quality of the 1972 Harrison and Harrison organ is simply not good enough. This, allied to an ever-increasing cost of maintenance, has led to the commissioning of Richards, Fowkes & Co to design and build an organ that will not only last for many years but will also provide the church with an instrument of the highest quality and the greatest musical flexibility. We feel sure that Handel would have approved!

The organ is in truth the grandest, the most daring, the most magnificent of all instruments invented by human beings" HONORE DE BALZAC

Richards, Fowkes & Co. are builders of organs in the classic late 18th, early 19th-century German/Dutch style. Based in Ooltewah, Tennessee, this is an organ builder with a magnificent reputation borne out by the quality of 17 organs already installed in such places as Chattanooga, Boston, Atlanta and Dallas. Our commission is unique, not only for Richards, Fowkes but also for American organ builders, as this will be the first organ from across "the pond" to be installed in London. Our new instrument continues Richards, Fowkes' North European inspirations for colour, clarity, and gravitas, while subtly shifting the emphasis towards the needs of the Anglican choir.

Opus XVIII will offer the Capital, perhaps, its most flexible, characterful, moderately-sized but comprehensive organ which will undoubtedly make a distinctive mark in both liturgical and concert use.

The Façade Pipes will be made of 98% lead (gilded) whilst all internal metal pipes will be made of virgin tin-lead alloys. The wind will be provided by multiple blowers and stabilizers from a silent electric blower. The organ will have an electric stop action whilst the compass of the manuals is 58 notes, the pedal is 30 notes.

Sponsor a Rank or a Pipe

Each pipe in Opus XVIII will play its own part in producing the magnificent blend of sounds the organ will offer. No single pipe is more important than another.
