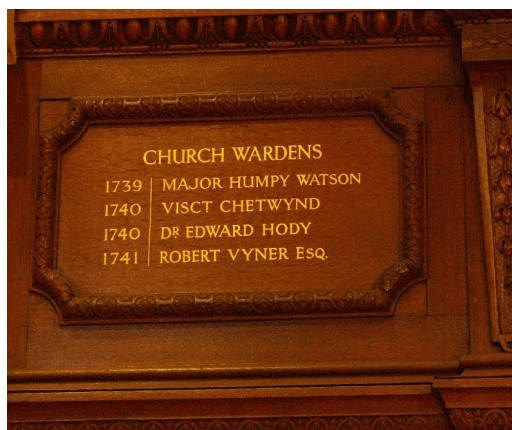

The walls of St George's Hanover Square trace the history of the church since 1725 through wood panels embossed with the names of every Churchwarden and Rector to have served Mayfair's parish church over the last three centuries.

They provide a lasting reminder of those who have made a significant contribution to this church, and the community around it, throughout its history.

Now, as St George's faces the challenge of its most major refurbishment for more than a century, it is only right that the support of individuals and institutions is recognised in a similar fashion—through prominent display on panels that will, for the generations that follow, become a permanent reminder of the generosity of our community today.



Recognition for all

The name of every donor to the Campaign for St George's will be recorded in a specially made Book of Gifts that will be on display within the church at all times. This will be an alphabetical listing of donor's names, handwritten. The book will be opened each day to show a different set of names.

In addition, the Campaign for St George's website : www.campaignforstgeorges.org will also have a webpage, updated regularly, that will show the names of all donors.

The level of gifts will not be shown and donors may, of course, choose to remain anonymous.

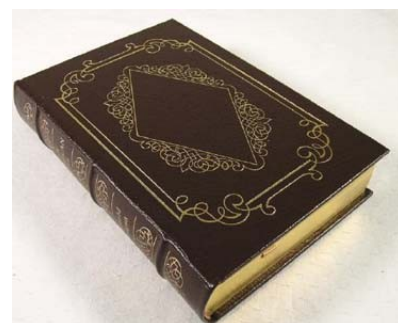
Whilst all gifts to the Campaign for St. George's will be publicly recognised (see below), not every one who makes a gift will be featured on the Campaign Donor Boards.

This privilege will be given to donors whose commitment is £10,000 or more, within the following categories:

Foundation Patron	£100,000
Custodian	£50,000
Patron	£25,000
Benefactor	£10,000

At each level there will be further benefits within the limits of those allowed under Gift Aid legislation.

DEDICATED GIFTS

The sensitive and tasteful refurbishment of St George's interior will be extensive. Within the programme of work scheduled, specific items of the Fabric—some of significant historical interest - will be restored.

PEW & BOX SPONSORSHIPS

From the very start of the original appeal, it has been possible for donors to “sponsor” a Pew and since 2007, several pews have been sponsored.

Pew sponsorships range from £5000 to £1000 and there is limited availability. Further details are available from the Campaign Office

The Boxes, on the balconies on either side of the church, are a feature of the church and were once “owned” by the great and the good, who enjoyed the privacy that they offered if not always the restricted views. The Boxes are in need of restoration and each offers an ideal opportunity for sponsorship. PLEDGED GIVING

All gifts to the Campaign for St George's can be made over a period of 4 years. This makes giving to the Campaign both affordable and effective. The chart below illustrates how pledged giving works. It also illustrates how Gift Aid can be used to enhance the value of a cash donation and help to reduce a tax liability for higher-rate taxpayers.
